Context



Ahead of the 2024-25 season, England Futsal are seeking to appoint a Head Coach for its Women's National Team to lead the team into forthcoming FIFA competition aligned to our safe, inclusive and insight led player pathway ambitions.





The Process

The timeline for the process is below. The application itself is detailed further below. All interviews will be conducted via Zoom.

This is an open recruitment process with all candidates being assessed by the contents of their application & performance at interview.

All applicants will receive a standardised response to allow us to inform everyone of outcomes in a timely manner, with the opportunity to request subsequent feedback.



The Application Deadlines

• Head Coach – Women's Senior National Team: Midnight 19.09.24

The Application

Applicants must submit an application for this role.

Candidates must submit a CV (in a minimum of size 10 font and covering no more than 2 sides of A4, including two references) and a supporting video lasting no more than 5 minutes.

Supporting Video

This video serves the function traditionally served by a covering letter and should look to elaborate how you would meet the job description and include answers to the following two questions.

1. Tell us what you consider are the biggest challenges and opportunities of leading a national team into competition? Describe why and how you would manage these situations? Please share relevant experiences to bring your examples to life.

2. Outline how you would periodise the preparation of a national team with limited contact time? State the steps you would take using relevant experience and examples.

We would encourage applicants to think about the following best practice when preparing for applications/interviews:

• Tailor your application to this opportunity.



- As a rule of thumb, use your CV to demonstrate how you meet the person specification, use your video to answer the questions above and bring to life how you would do the job aligned to the job description.
- Use 'CAR' (Context, Action, Result) as a structure to formulate your answers. It is a useful way to think about how to convey the situation you were in, the action you as an individual took and what resulted from that action. You don't want a 'cookie cutter' answer, but thinking through in this way will help you succinctly demonstrate impact.

Alongside your CV & supporting video, please submit proof of your UEFA B Futsal Coaching Award and updated first aid and safeguarding qualifications. Any applications that do not include all elements (CV, Video, proof of UEFA B, safeguarding & first aid qualifications) will not proceed to the shortlisting stage.

Applicants must be available for interview on the day specified for the role applied for. If the date set is a challenge, there is a potential opportunity to explore rescheduling. In this event, please inform England Futsal of any challenges when offered an interview.
